BACHELOR OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION (B.P.Ed.)

Bachelor of physical education is a two year professional degree program with the objective of preparing physical education teacher to impart physical education and sports activities. The course will also facilitate employment for them as physical education teacher, trainers/ instructors/ coaches in schools, fitness centers, health club, sports academy etc.



B.P.Ed. Admission Examination- 2021

DURATION: Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) program is a professional program which will be of duration of two academic sessions.

ELIGIBILITY: Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and at least participation in Inter-Collegiate/ Inter-Zonal/ District/ School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU / IOA / SGFI / Government of India.

OR

Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.

OR

Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and study of physical education as compulsory/ elective subject.

OR

Bachelor's degree in any disciplines with 45% marks and having participated in National/ Inter University / State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College / Inter-Zonal / District / School competition in sports and games as recognized by AIU / IOA / SGFI / Government of India.

OR

Bachelor's degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National / Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by the respective federations/ AIU / IOA / SGFI / Government of India.

OR

Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years teaching experience: (For deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

NOTE:

In the light of provisions of reservation given for EWS category candidates in UP Combined B. Ed. Entrance Test and Counselling-2020, 10 percent of total of seats are reserved for candidates of EWS category in this programme.

Seats thus reserved for EWS category candidates shall remain vacant in case eligible candidates of EWS category are not available for admission in the programme.

WEIGHTAGE:

E. The redeemable weightage will be provided to the candidates in the following manner:

- (i). 2 percent for students of Colleges affiliated to Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University.
- (ii). 5 percent to the candidates who hold qualifying degree from University Campus.
- (iii). 2 percent for female candidates.
- (iv). 2 Percent Students having “B” & “C” Certificate in NCC.
- (v). 2 Percent NSS (Work of 240 Hours and 1 camp).
- (vi). 2 Percent Students of Rovers / Rangers (Scout & Guide).

NOTE: Not more than two of the weightage criteria can be added. Not more than 7 percent weightage will be applicable to a candidate on the basis of any two criteria.

Comment: No more than two of the above mentioned weightages shall be added together.

Comment: The benefit of this weightage will be given only for admission in the University campus and affiliated Government / Aided Colleges.

The reservation of seats for SC /ST /Other Backward Caste /PWD and other categories will be as per Central Government or State Government rules.

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION: B.P.Ed. Entrance examination will be completed in two stages (written examination of 50 marks and physical fitness test of 50 marks). For admission, it is mandatory for the candidate to appear in both the stages of the entrance examination. There will be a total 100 questions in the written examination. Each question will be of 1/2 marks. In Physical Fitness Test, applicants have to participate in 05 items of 10 marks each (i.e. 600mt. race, 50mt. dash run, 4X10mt. shuttle run, Medicine Ball Throw and Standing Broad Jump).

SYLLABUS OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION: Indian Players and their achievements, Olympic History, Indian Sports History (Olympic Games, Asian Games and International Competitions), Individual and Team Games, Sports Grounds and Sports Equipment, Sports Skills and Sports Awards, Yoga and Physical Education, Reasoning ability, General Studies and General Awareness, National and International events.

NOTE:

A relaxation of 5% in the eligibility of B.P.Ed. Programme will be given to the candidates belonging to SC / ST category.

The pregnant women are not eligible for B.P.Ed. Programme.

Reservation provisioned for OBC/SC/ST candidates shall not be applicable in admission in self-finance college.

If the number of applicants are less than the number of prescribed seats, the admission process (counselling) will be done by making the merit on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the physical fitness test only.
